

## Academy Dress Code

We pride ourselves with high standards of dress in school and ask for the co-operation of students and parents in maintaining these. A high standard of dress impacts on the working ethos of the Academy and how the wider community views our students.

### **Boys (Years 7-11)**

**Academy Blazer** – Academy regulation royal blue blazer, with official Academy badge (compulsory)

**House Tie** – clip on style

**Trousers** – plain charcoal grey, regular fit only

**Shirt** – formal sky blue, long sleeves with stiff collar

**Pullover** – grey, V-neck with official Academy logo (optional)

**Socks** – plain black

**Shoes** – plain black (no maker's logo) lace-up or slip-on shoes in a formal style that are cut below the ankle. Please note that boots, trainers and cloth plimsolls are not permitted.

**Coat** – (non-compulsory) plain raincoat, duffel or anorak. A discreet logo is permissible. Coats are not to be worn within the Academy during the working day. Denim, leather jackets and hoodies are not permitted.

**Religious Headwear** – plain black

### **Girls (Years 7-11)**

**Academy Blazer** – Academy regulation royal blue blazer, with official Academy badge (compulsory)

**House Tie** – clip on style

**Skirt or Trousers** – plain, charcoal grey, half pleated knee length skirt or plain, charcoal grey, regular fit trousers only

**Tunic** – charcoal grey

**Shirt** – formal sky blue, long sleeves with stiff collar

**Pullover** – grey, V-neck with official Academy logo (optional)

**Socks/Tights** – plain black ankle socks or plain black tights. Knee length tights are not permitted.

**Shoes** – plain black (no maker's logo) lace-up or slip-on shoes in a formal style that are cut below the ankle. Please note that boots, trainers and cloth plimsolls are not permitted.

**Coat** – (non-compulsory) plain raincoat, duffel or anorak. A discreet logo is permissible. Coats are not to be worn within the Academy during the working day. Denim, leather jackets and hoodies are not permitted.

**Religious Headwear** – plain black

### **Summer Uniform**

At times of extreme heat students will be informed by the Head teacher when ties and blazers may be taken off in the Academy. However, it is expected they will be worn on journeys to and from school and on school trips.

### **Jewellery**

Students are allowed to wear a watch only. Religious necklaces and jewellery will be worn under clothing. Earrings, facial piercings and ear lobe stretchers are not permitted. If students disregard this they will be isolated from other students until they comply with the regulation.

### **Hairstyles and Attire**

Baseball caps are not permitted in any circumstances.

Hairstyles should not be extreme. Parents should consult, in advance, with the Head of Year if they are unsure as to the suitability of a change of hairstyle or hair colour. The school shall be the arbiter of the term 'extreme'.

### **Make-up**

Make-up and nail polish are not permitted. In exceptional circumstances light foundation will be permitted to disguise skin complaints. The school shall be the arbiter of the term 'exceptional circumstances'.

False nails are not permitted.

**ALL** students will require an appropriate school bag containing; a pencil case, reading book and a homework planner.

## **PE Kit**

All students are expected to bring appropriate kit to all PE lessons. They should pay careful attention to which activities they will be participating in. Students who fail to bring appropriate PE kit for their lesson will be provided with clean garments to ensure their full participation in the lesson.

### **Girls' kit**

**Shirt** – House PE shirt with Djanogly logo

**Shorts** – Navy PE shorts (must be brought to all lessons)

**Tracksuit Trousers** – Navy tracksuit trousers (optional) - the wearing of these will depend on the activity, the weather conditions and will be at the teacher's discretion

**Socks** – Navy football socks & white sports socks

**Footwear** – Training shoes appropriate to the activity/sport & football boots (moulded studs/blades)

**Other** – Swimming costume, shin pads, mouth guard, towel

### **Boys' kit**

**Shirt** – House PE shirt with Djanogly logo

**Shorts** – Navy PE shorts. Shorts must be brought to all lessons

**Tracksuit Trousers** – Navy tracksuit trousers (optional) - the wearing of these will depend on the activity, the weather conditions and will be at the teacher's discretion

**Socks** – Navy football socks & white sports socks

**Footwear** – Training shoes appropriate to the activity/sport and football boots (moulded studs/blades)

**Other** – Swimming trunks, shin pads, mouth guard, towel

All students will also need a carrying bag for their PE kit and a plastic bag is recommended for carrying dirty boots.

Except in the case of serious injury, all students are expected to come to PE lessons prepared to take part in some physical activity or adopt another role within the lesson. If students have minor ailments they should bring a note from home explaining this and still bring their kit to participate appropriately.
